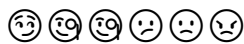

My supposition is that some missionaries actually did come with a goal to spread what they believed to be the "true religion" and might not have had any contact or interaction with the colonialists. For example Ludwig Krapft a German missionary to East Africa, first arrived in East Africa in 1841 and Kenya was declared a British protectorate in 1920. That shows in my opinion a probable variation in intentions and probably long term goals.

M'siri was a human and gold trafficker; his kingdom last only few decades

Notons que le Kongo dia Ntotila était essentiellement encore dans l'ère du cuivre et n'a connu le fer que par ce guerrier-magicien Moteke, comme le dernier peuple Bantou à connaître le fer, maîtrisé au Mali, au Nigeria, en RCA, au Soudan et au Burundi depuis 2000 à 3000 ans avant J.C., soit longtemps avant l'Europe.... Si il est évident que le royaume fut bien administré, ayant développé une écriture du type hiéroglyphique, un calcul décimal par positionnement nommant même le million( efuku ) - forcément pas le nombre des épouses ou des chèvres du roi....- ,et gérait des réseaux commerciaux à fort longue distance, imposant la pratique des nzimbu ( coquillages-monnaie) recoltés à Luanda dans le commerce avec au moins les Bateke d'Anzika, la reine rebelle Nzinga ne fut pas Mukongo, mais ennemie du Kongo Dia Ntotila et esclavagiste elle-même, tandis que si Kimpa Vita , princesse Ne Kongo, certes, a causé un bref renaissance du royaume et de la capitale Mbanza Kongo, on est obligé d'admettre qu'elle souffrait de la schizophrénie au point que son oeuvre s'en fracassait ; sans ses délires, les pères n'auraient jamais pu la saisir, ni la brûler vive avec son enfant - immaculé conception avec Saint Antoine...- Autre chose, AVANT cette dynastie, il y avait déjà la monnaie Mbongo, un tissu que tous pouvaient fabriquer, ce qui allait attacher une valeur de travail stable à la monnaie .....et donc une valeur de marché - en fonction des disponibilités - des autres produits ....Ainsi, par le Mbongo et le mariage obligé aux Nsaku Lau, on comprend qu'il y avait déjà une société complexe et diversifiée avant la prise de pouvoir par Lukeni y Nimy ( ou autre ..., il y a contradiction à ce sujet, et aucun moyen ne permet de trancher. On ne sait même pas si le Roi ayant reçu les portugais était 3°,4° ou 5° de la dynastie...( mon beau-père fut Nsambu Ntotila, un temps traité par le Prince Ne Kongo, rebelle et voleur Holden Roberto comme "roi des Bakongo" et nommé quelques semaines comme "gouverneur de Mbanza Kongo".... )... Il est FAUX que le Ntotila Affonso se serait opposé à la traite d'esclaves - ridicule méconnaissance même du système endogène d'esclavagisme : c'est la caste sans métier ni terre....des condamnés et prisonniers de guerre à l'origine.... Par contre, il voulait en contrôler la commerce, et distribuer l'accès aux produits de traite, or les Portugais traitaient directement avec les nobles de N'soyo et Kakongo, produisant la dislocation du royaume ; en plus, ces nobles soumis ainsi s'affranchissaient, et arirvaient à même capturer des membres des castes élevées. ( Ainsi l'écriture Kongo fut au moins jusqu'il y a 50 ans conservée par la société secrète des guérisseurs Saramakka ( Marrons de Suriname), les Adoki....). A 7 minutes 52 secondes je me suis arrêté. Valeur du document zéro. Même pas un travail sérieux , comme si notre Histoire ne justifie pas cela et qu'on peut se permettre de ne pas prendre au sérieux l'Histoire Africaine....
